

OWL COVID-19 GUIDELINES – Spring 2021

If you have physical access to the Oklahoma Weather Lab, you must forward your “all-clear” COVID confirmation email to Shawn Riley (rileysp@ou.edu)

In accordance with OU official policy, when within the Oklahoma Weather Lab at any time it is a requirement that a face mask must be worn properly.

GENERAL USAGE: Due to COVID-19 restrictions, physical access to the Oklahoma Weather Lab won't be possible for our members. If you are not a shift leader or a board member and feel that you need direct access to the lab, please contact Jenna Warner (jennastormwarner@ou.edu), Joel Kirschenman (joel.kirschenman@ou.edu), and Shawn Riley (rileysp@ou.edu).

SHIFTS: Only shift leaders will be allowed in the lab during shifts in order to use the proper equipment required to run a shift (both morning and evening). All shift attendees will be remote and able to attend via a video camera set up in the lab or the shift leader's personal devices. When shift leaders are in the lab, they will be asked to clean and sanitize their area before leaving (wipes and/or gloves will be provided) and wear their mask for the entirety of their shift.

GREEN ROOM: Only one person allowed in the room at a time due to space/size of the room. Upon leaving, green room users will also be asked to sanitize their area before leaving. For recording, a mask can be off only when the door to the room is closed. Masks must be worn properly any time the door is open in the green room.

GENERAL MEETINGS: All general meetings will be held virtually, and this includes HOOT meetings or any other OWL event.

BOARD MEETINGS: All board meetings will remain on Zoom/Microsoft Teams.
